The Town of Fredonia has been protected since the 1970's by a flood retarding structure, and we call her fondly, "The Dike."

She has protected the town for over 50 years from flooding catastrophies and she has done her job well with the design that was first put in. Like mother nature she has cradled our town in her arms and protected us from the disasters that can happen from the rains and the flooding. Because of her we have not had the tragedies that happened in 2015 in Colorado City, Arizona, which is just 30 miles west of us.

Like all good things that come to an end eventually, our dike is expired in the standards of safety. So with that said we as a town need to write our senators or representatives about our dike because we need to find a way to come up with about \$3.5 million by the end of the year to meet the required safety standards, which is out of our reach as a small town.

The USDAs Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) are helping us with funding, but we are limited in the ways we can raise the additional money. If our portion of the funding cannot be raised, we will have to breach our dear dike, which will end up flooding our schools, many of our homes, businesses and the town's cemetery.

So what we the community can do is go on to FredoniaAZ.net and go on the sight about the dike and it'll tell you how you can help by writing your senator or representative. The site will help educate you on how to do the things that might just help with the funding that is needed.

So let's pull together as a community and see if we can't save our dearly beloved "Dike." After all 50 is awful young to go out of commission!
