They chronicle the lifestyles from the early pioneer families through the timber industry and mining periods in the area.

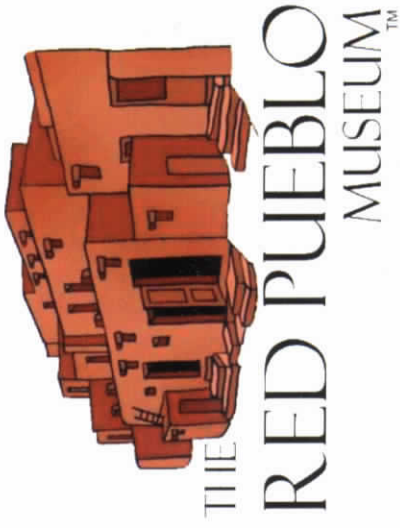


Covered picnic tables and restrooms are available at the Heritage Park

Hidden in the foothills less than a mile East of Fredonia are ancient petroglyphs. These petroglyphs are located in a rock formation known as the Clam Shell. It is a short rocky hike up the formation. Good sturdy shoes are recommended.
